Dear School Community,

As we enter further into Mission Month, I have seen many examples of our students and staff finding ways to serve and support others. It is in this spirit, and with the gospel value of treating others as you would like to be treated that the bulk of the newsletter is from other members of our hard working teaching staff.

We wanted to take a moment to share some of the learning and wellbeing themes we've been focusing on with students recently, particularly around emotional regulation, fairness, and honesty in play.

During our Wellbeing sessions, students have been exploring how we can help each other set up for success, identify boundaries, and respond appropriately when we encounter unwanted behaviour. We have discussed the importance of playing fairly, following the rules, and showing good sportsmanship — especially when it comes to games that involve winning, losing, or tagging.





Across the yard, staff have been supporting students to manage their emotions and interactions in play. Sometimes, students may find it difficult to accept outcomes such as being tagged, losing a turn, or hearing comments from others that are not meant personally. When these moments occur, we encourage students to pause, use a calming strategy, and seek help from a teacher if needed.





To support these skills, we are reinforcing two key strategies:

Responding to unwanted behaviour:

- 1. No: "Please stop, I don't like that because..."
- 2. **Go:** Move away and take space.
- 3. **Tell:** Ask a teacher for help.

For self-regulation:

- 1. **Stop:** Use a calming strategy (deep breathing, walking away, getting a drink).
- 2. Think: Consider options.
- 3. **Do:** Choose the best response.

We also encourage students to think about the activities that help them feel calm and successful during break times. Teachers are supporting students to plan for positive play experiences, whether that is downball, drawing, reading, or joining a group game.

You can help at home by talking with your child about:

- The importance of honesty and fairness in games.
- How to respond calmly when things don't go their way.
- Respecting others' boundaries and listening to teachers or peers when they ask for space.
- Planning what games or activities they might enjoy during playtime.

Thank you for your ongoing support as we work together to build positive play habits and emotional maturity across the year level. These are important lifelong skills that help our students form strong friendships, enjoy fair play, and feel confident resolving challenges respectfully.

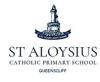
